

School Policy On Children Being Put Out Of Class

Under Part 2 of the Education Act Section 1

Students Rights And Responsibilities

Page 565 Subject to available resources, all persons are entitled to receive an Educational Programme appropriate to their needs in accordance with this Act.

Page 567 parents to appeal decisions that significantly affect the education, health or safety of their children.

As a result of the above, the Marigot Secondary School does not believe that any student should be put out of class. Instead, the following are suggested:

1. After being warned, Teachers may ask students to stand at the back of the class or near the door for the duration of the class (Teachers should require that the student does any work done during the class)
2. After class, Teachers should discuss the matter with the student and deal with it appropriately.

If the above fails

3. The matter may be referred to the Dean of Discipline, Vice Principal or Principal.

NB: The Principal reserves the right to take the necessary action to reinstate the child in the class.
